



1. POSSIBLE DANGERS ON THE FACTORY PREMISES

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Danger of serious injury due to collision with vehicles • General fire hazards • Danger of fires and explosions with serious injuries in potentially explosive areas • Danger from falling loads • Danger of crushing and being pulled into machines • Danger from charging batteries • Danger of chemical burns caused by acids and alkalis upon contact with hazardous substances • Risk of permanent hearing damage in noisy areas • Danger of eye injury from uncontrolled moving parts (dust, grains, etc.)

2. BEHAVIOUR RULES

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Register before entering/driving the storage area! Let your contact person inform you about the possible dangers! • It is essential to observe posted information on the organization of first aid and fire protection, as well as operating instructions and labels posted at workstations! • Drive at walking speed throughout the entire storage area! Mutual foresight and consideration! Make eye contact with the other people! • Pedestrians are required to wear safety shoes and reflective clothing at a minimum throughout the storage area; PPE according to the respective labeling! • Smoking, sparking and open flames are prohibited in the entire storage area; Smoking is only permitted at designated smoking points. • Work that produces sparks (welding, flexing, etc.) requires written permission from the factory management! • When carrying out external work, only use safe, suitable and tested work equipment! • Eating and drinking from open containers only in the designated areas or in cars/trucks! • Stay only in the area assigned at registration. As far as possible, use pedestrian routes and avoid vehicle traffic routes; no unauthorized use of equipment or entry into other parts of the company! • Do not stay in shelf areas where things are being stored/retrieved at the same time!

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fight emerging fires using a fire extinguisher – pay attention to self-protection! • Inform the next employee and, if necessary, arrange for an evacuation / fire alarm / activate the manual button (adjust the text here accordingly) • Emergency call from cell phone 112, from extension telephone 112 • Go to the company's assembly point and pay attention to further instructions
